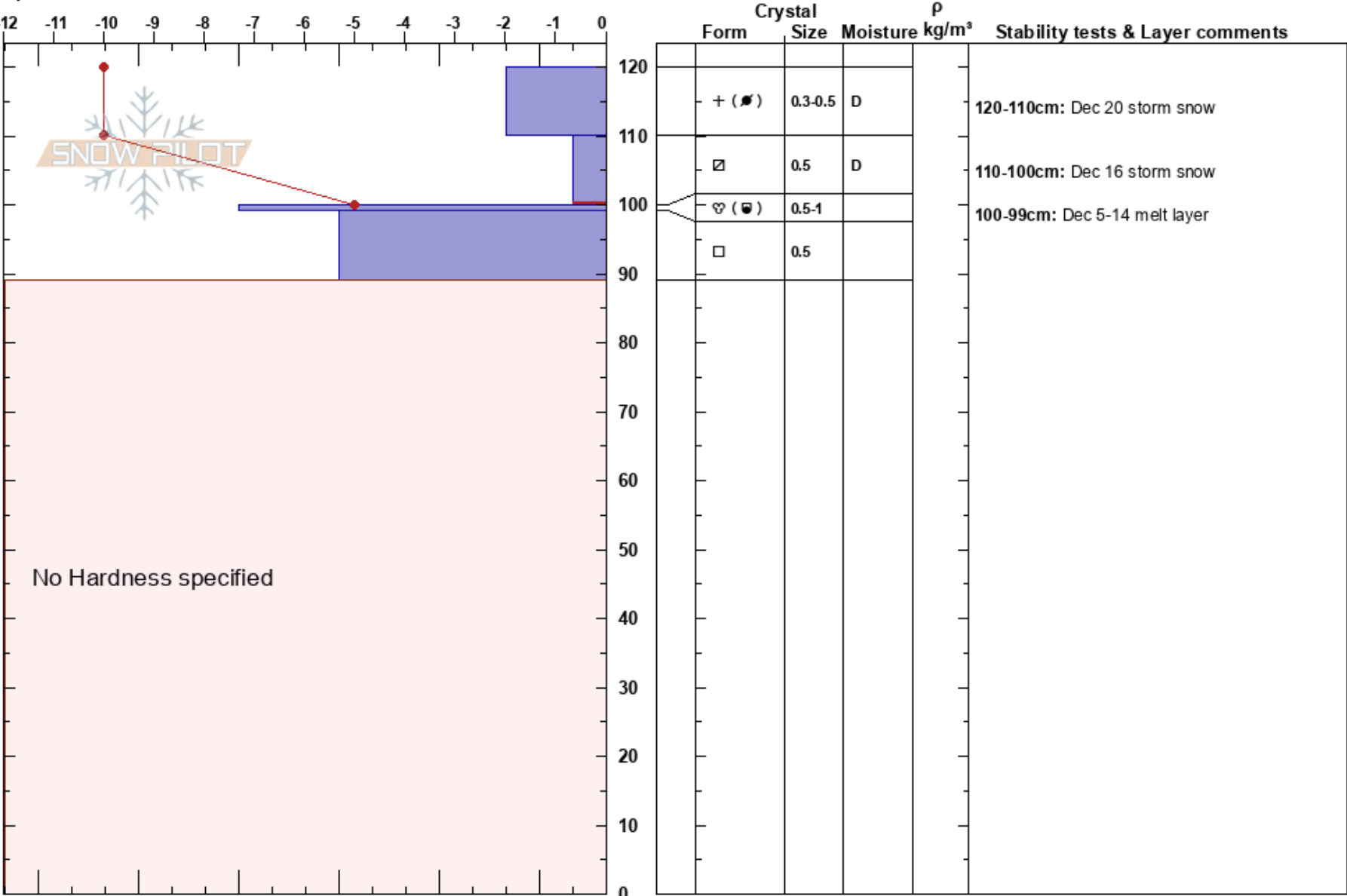

Notes: This pit is located in closed terrain at the Mt Rose ski area. It is representative of the backcountry. The location is in the Chutes just below the first shot point at the top of Yellowjacket on a NE aspect below a large rock. We did not preform a column test, however we did ski cut the slope multiple times with negative results.
