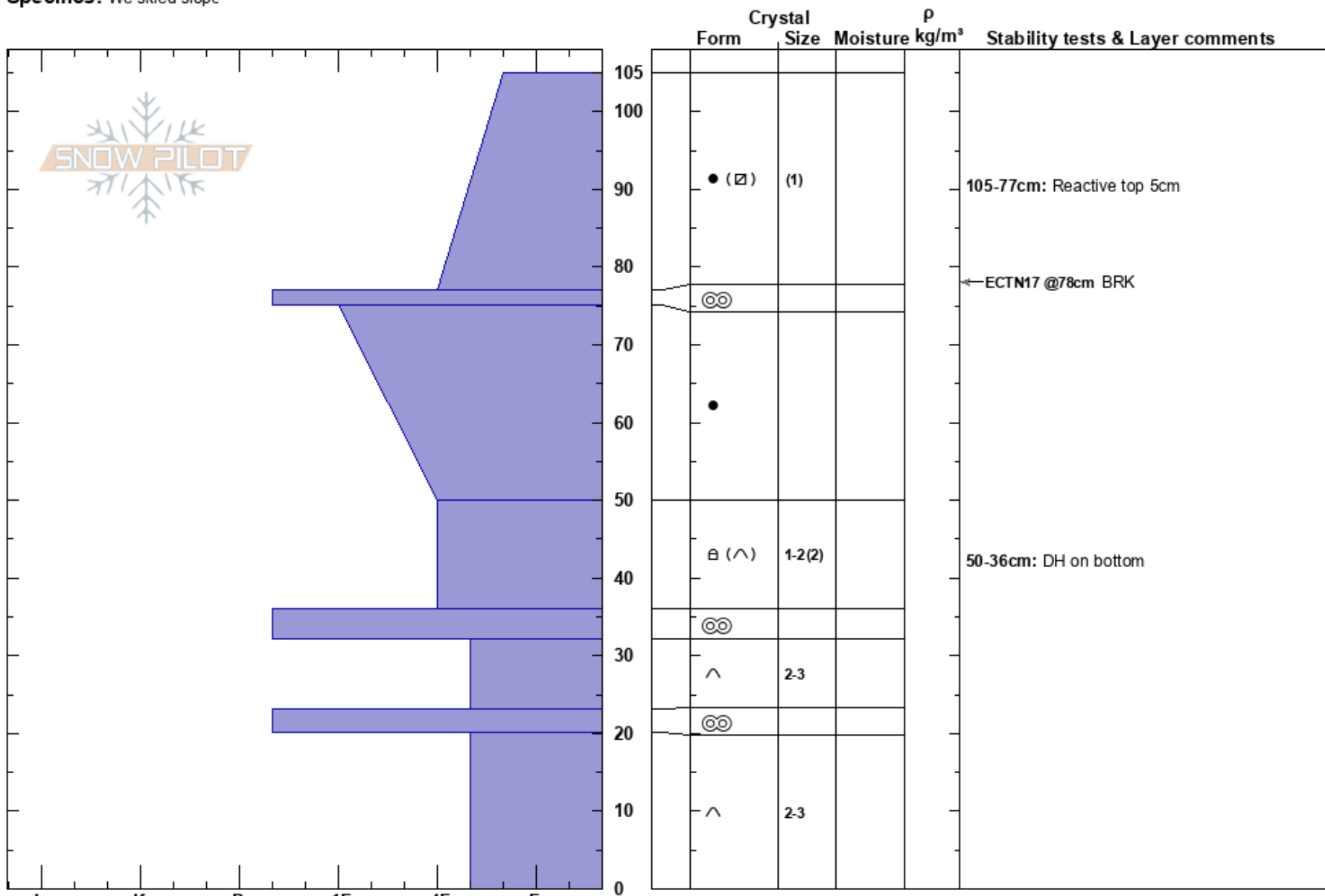

Notes: With a green light and no instability seen in the drainage over multiple days, we decided to skin up, dig a pit, and ride Barrieto in Mineral Fork. The snow was variable with a mix of dense pow, wind skin, shallow wind drifts, and firm wind crust with graupel on top. It was warm down low, but above 8500ft the snow was still cold and dry. The faceting that's taken place on the top layer of snow is reactive to wind loading
