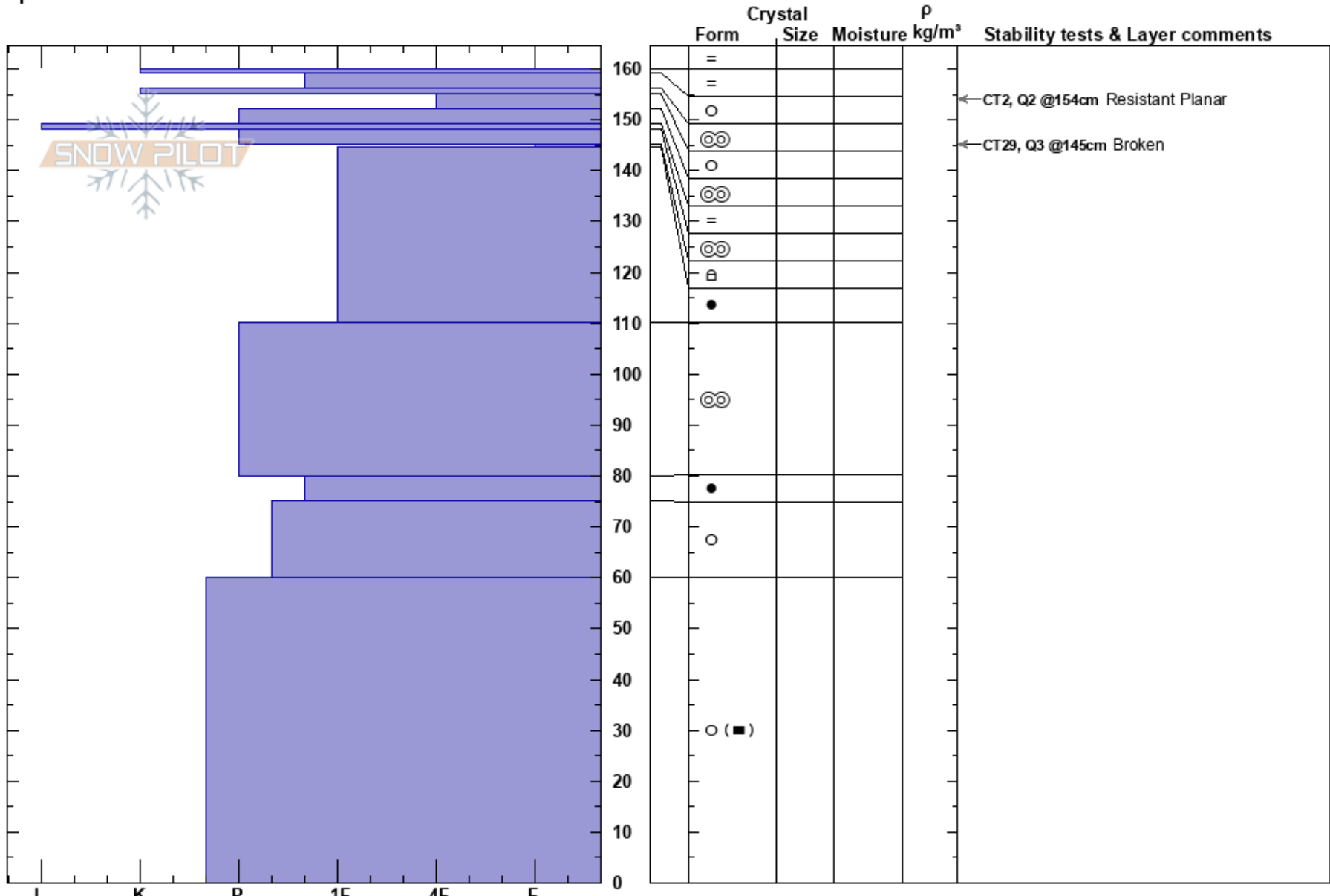

Notes: Near treeline location with scoured surface (1cm rain crust). Many crusts and melt forms in upper snowpack sandwiched by melt forms. Most stout crust is 1cm thick ice crust at 148cm, with 3cm melt/freeze crust above and below. Below this Melt Freeze crust found shallow layer of small rounding facets. Difficult to disturb with thick crusts above, but had a broken CT29 on this layer. Did not dig past 40cm to ground.
