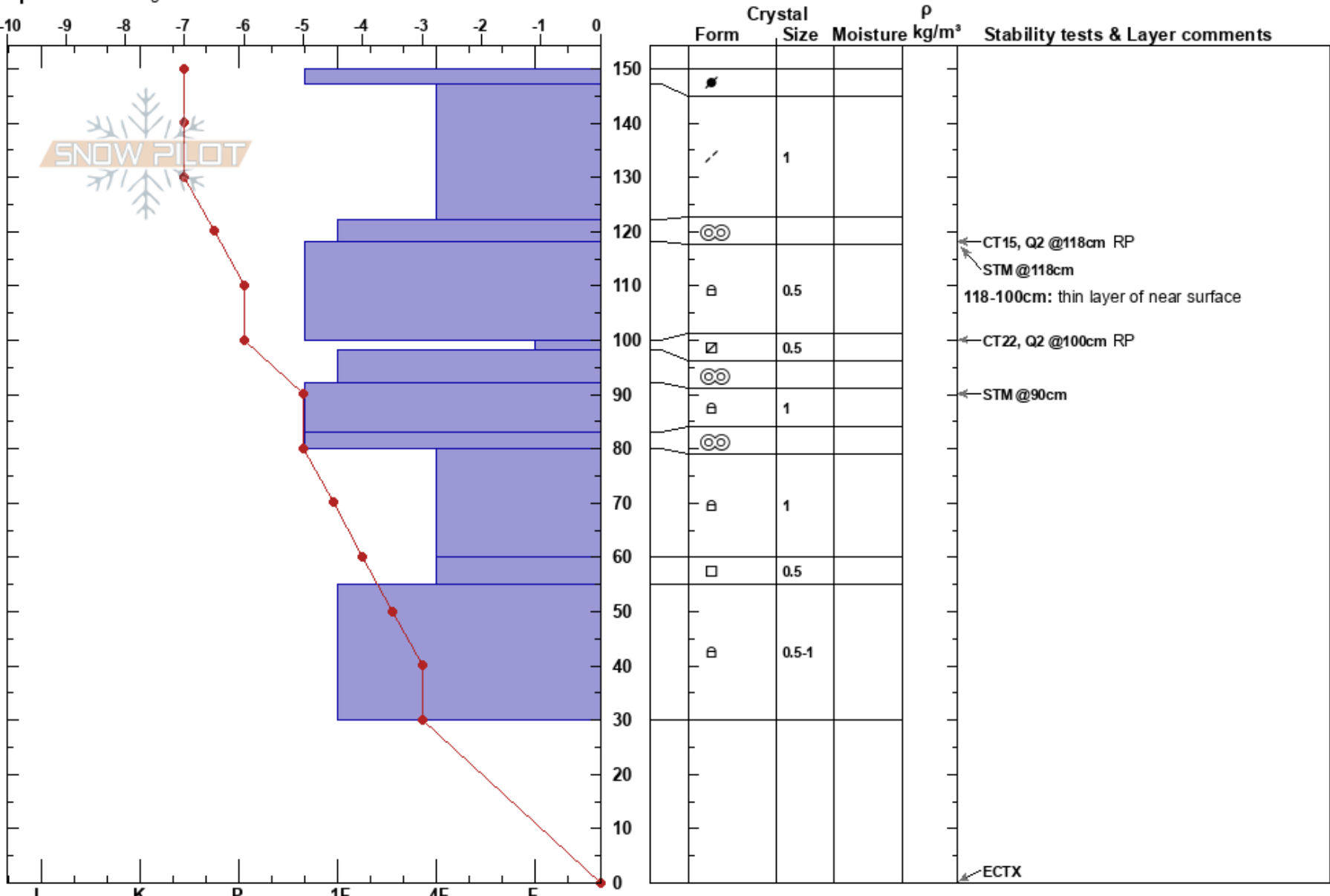

I am concerned with the thin layer of Near Surface Facets that are living on top of a Melt Freeze crust. Need to keep close watch on that layer.
