

Pit is representative of weak layer avalanche failed on. Crown face was more like 4-7' deep, 150' wide running 800' vertical feet. Crown face was hard slab 1f+ isolated to a rocky steep gully feature. Photos below show deeper crown face. Pit location was on skiers right side of upper crown in a lower angle area.
