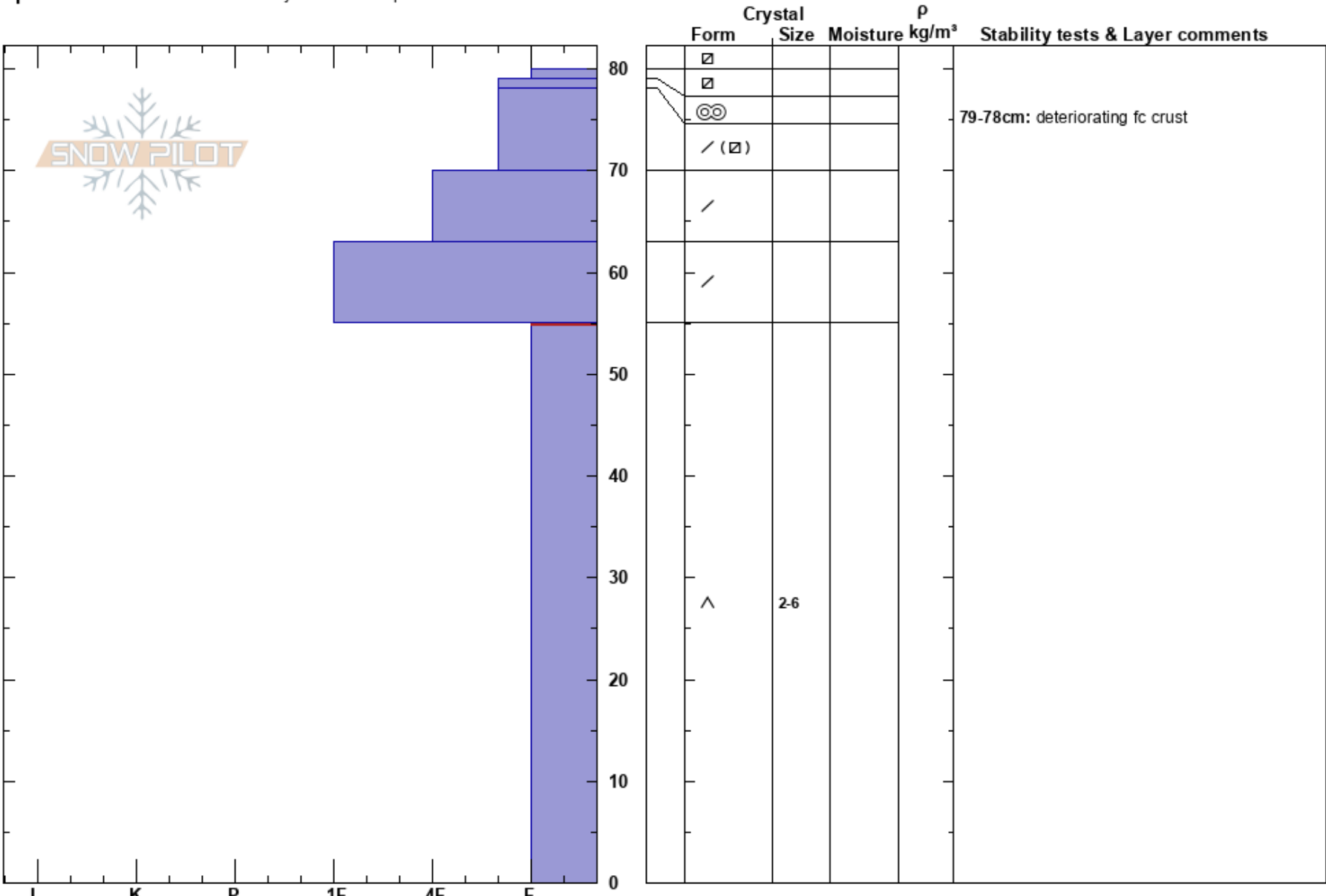

Notes: Winds picked up ridgetops gusting to strong from the SSW. This pit was adjacent to an avalanche that was skier triggered on January 30, 2024. Pit is representative of weak layer avalanche failed on. Crown face was more like 4-7' deep, 150' wide running 800' vertical feet. Crown face was hard slab 1f+ isolated to a rocky steep gully feature. Photos below show deeper crown face. Pit location was on skiers right side of upper crown in a lower angle area.
