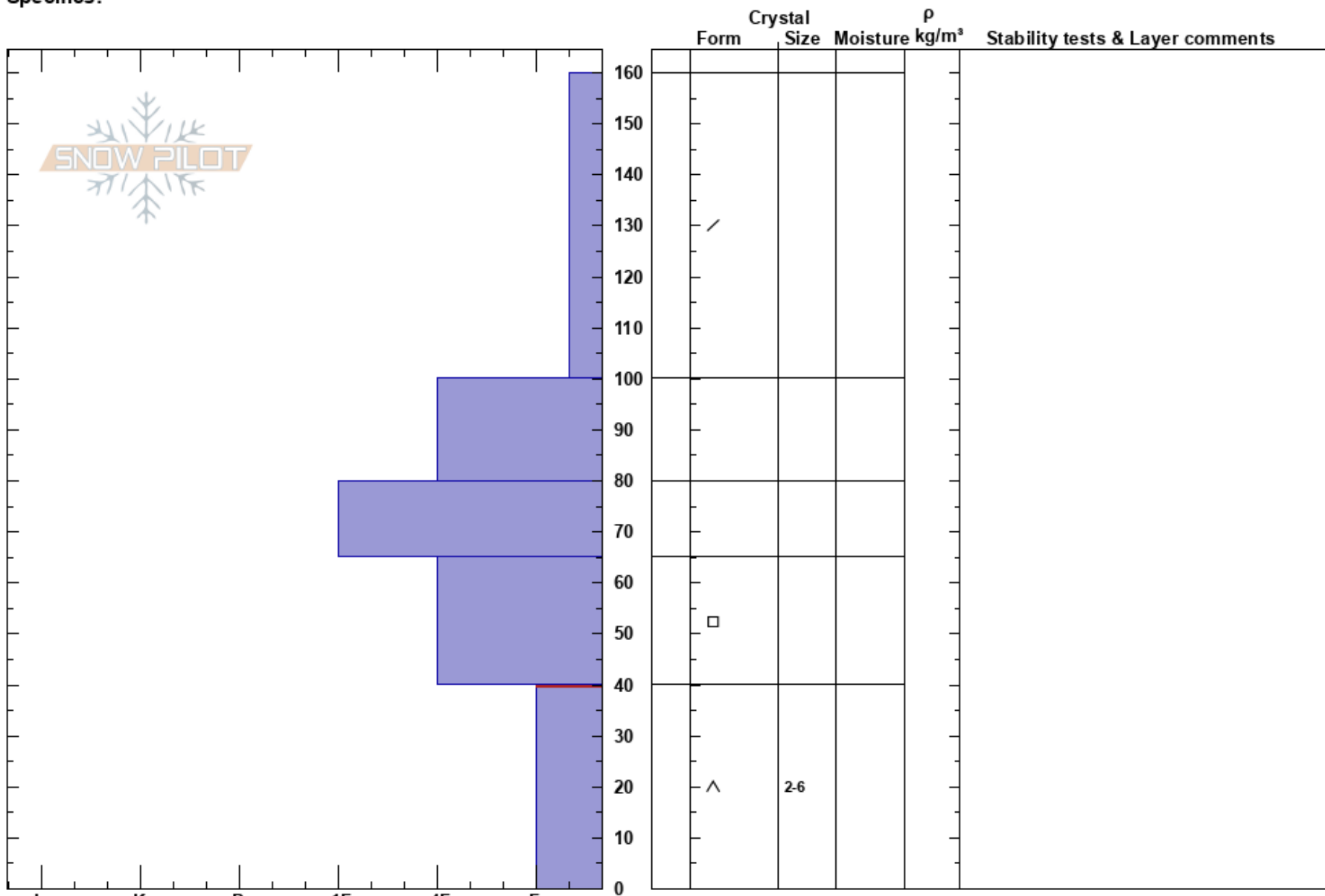

**Notes:** This snowpit was dug in a similar spot to a pit on 2/1/2024 and an avalanche from 1/30/2024. There is now an additional 80cm of snow over the weak layer for a total slab depth of of 120cm in this location. The weak layer is as weak as it was with more weight over the top. Thicker snowpack does not equal stronger snowpack.
