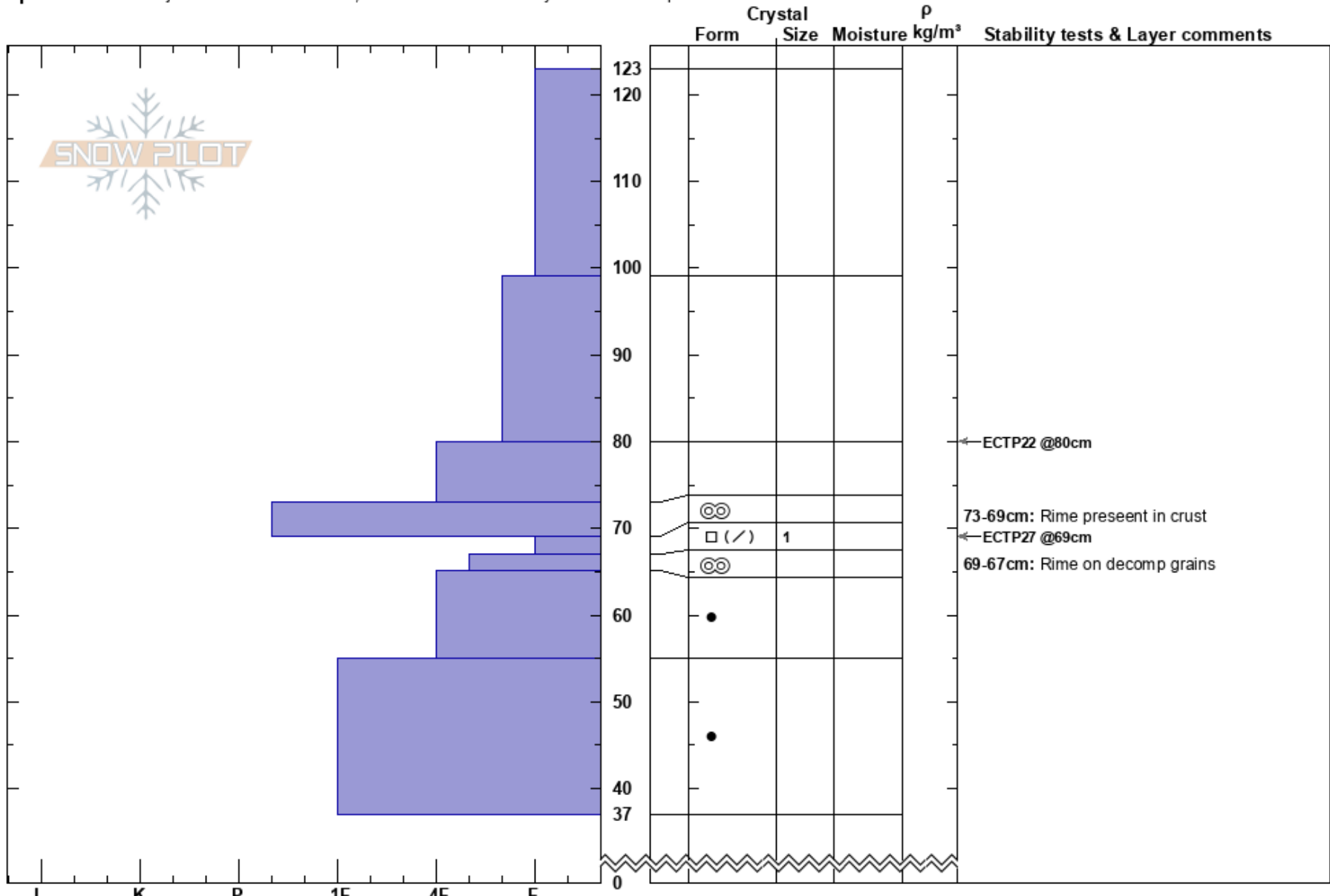

**Notes:** Natural avalanche occurred on this slope on 2/7. The bed surface was filled in with about 15 inches of new snow. Pit is adjacent to right flank, just below the crown. Max depth of crown is just over 2 ft. The avalanche failed on the facets below the (P-) melt freeze crust at 69cm.
