

Notes: Two recent natural avalanches (night before) were seen at the non-operating Teton Pass Ski Resort. Both were East aspect, 38-40 degree start zones and crown depth appeared to be 10-20 inches. The main chute (Pipeline) ran into Moondance and made it to the road (SS-N-R2D2-I), and also Joe's Wave ran in the steepest start zone (40 degrees) and deposited snow just above the Waterfall (SS-N-R2D2-I).
