

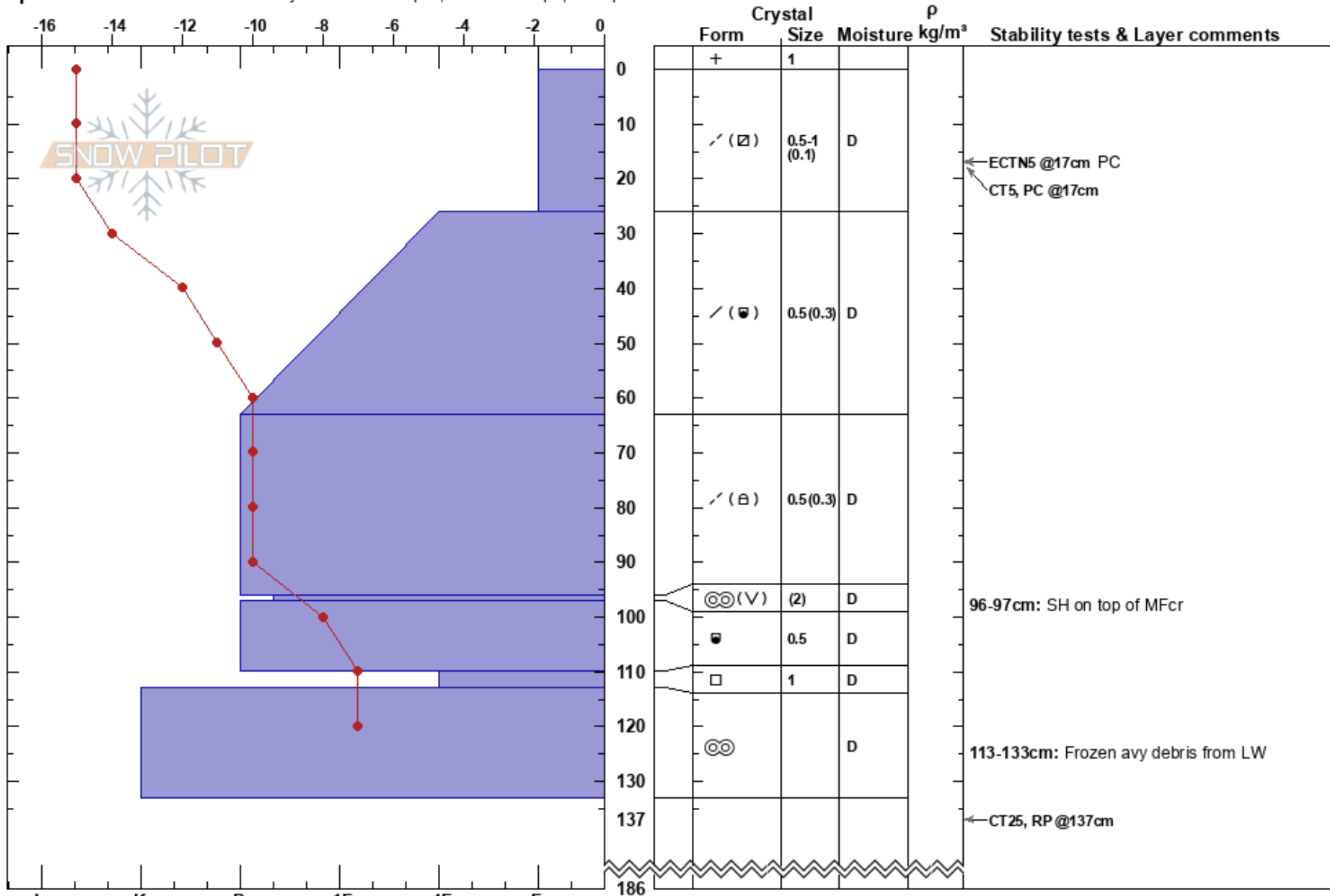

Specifics: Recent avalanche activity on different slopes; We skied slope; Poor pit location



Notes: We chose a poor pit location under Liberty Bell that is likely not representative of other start zones. We found frozen LW avalanche debris at the bottom of our pit. The LW cycle that deposited this debris likely corresponds with the formation of the Early February Crust observed throughout much of the range. Any stability tests in this pit will not likely be representative of the strength of this interface on other slopes.
