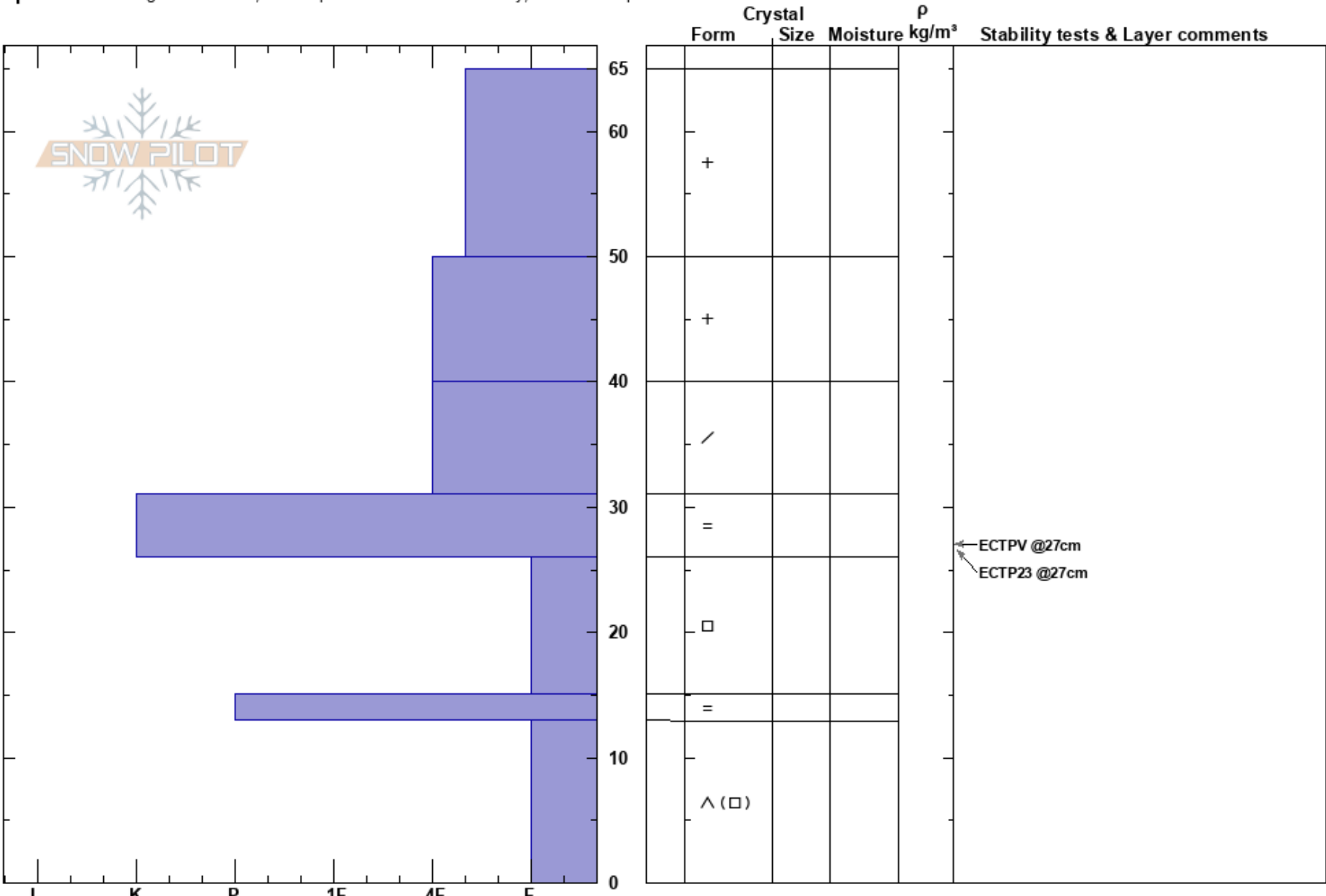

**Notes:** 20-30 Cm PP/DF past 96 hrs @1900m and above without little wind effect observed, this new addition to the snow pack overlays a relatively poor snow structure (may snow) with multiple Crusts and Fc /DH layers. Currently no avalanche issues has be observed however this could become a problem with >20cm of PPavailable for transport. This layer is to be monitored for change in structure and load
