

The PWL at the ground and the PWL between the two MF crusts are facets within the first meter of our shallow pack with one step of hardness difference from adjacent layers, so both layers have 3 lemons. The snow at the ground appears to be weakest at fist minus hardness, so this was my layer of concern initially, but the layer between the MF crusts is less than 10 cm in thickness, giving it an additional lemon.
