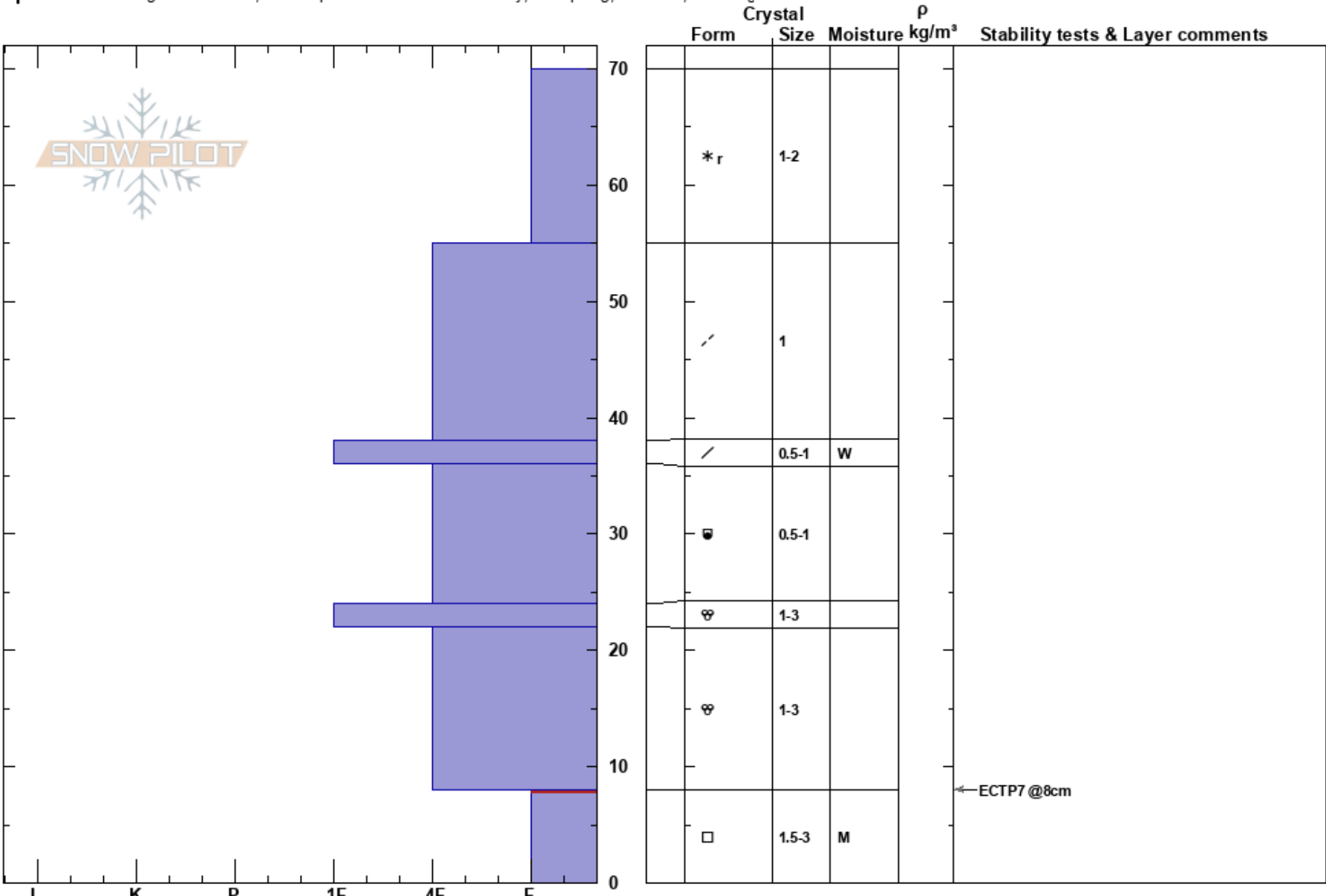

Notes: As I climbed to the pit location, I noticed a crack 6-8 in deep that wrapped from the bottom of the slope up to where I dug, across the slope 100+ ft. and back down to the bottom of the path. Snow was being transported quickly enough to fully bury my skis over the 25 minutes or so I was at the pit. All layers observed were well-defined and line up well with air temperature changes over the past week.
