

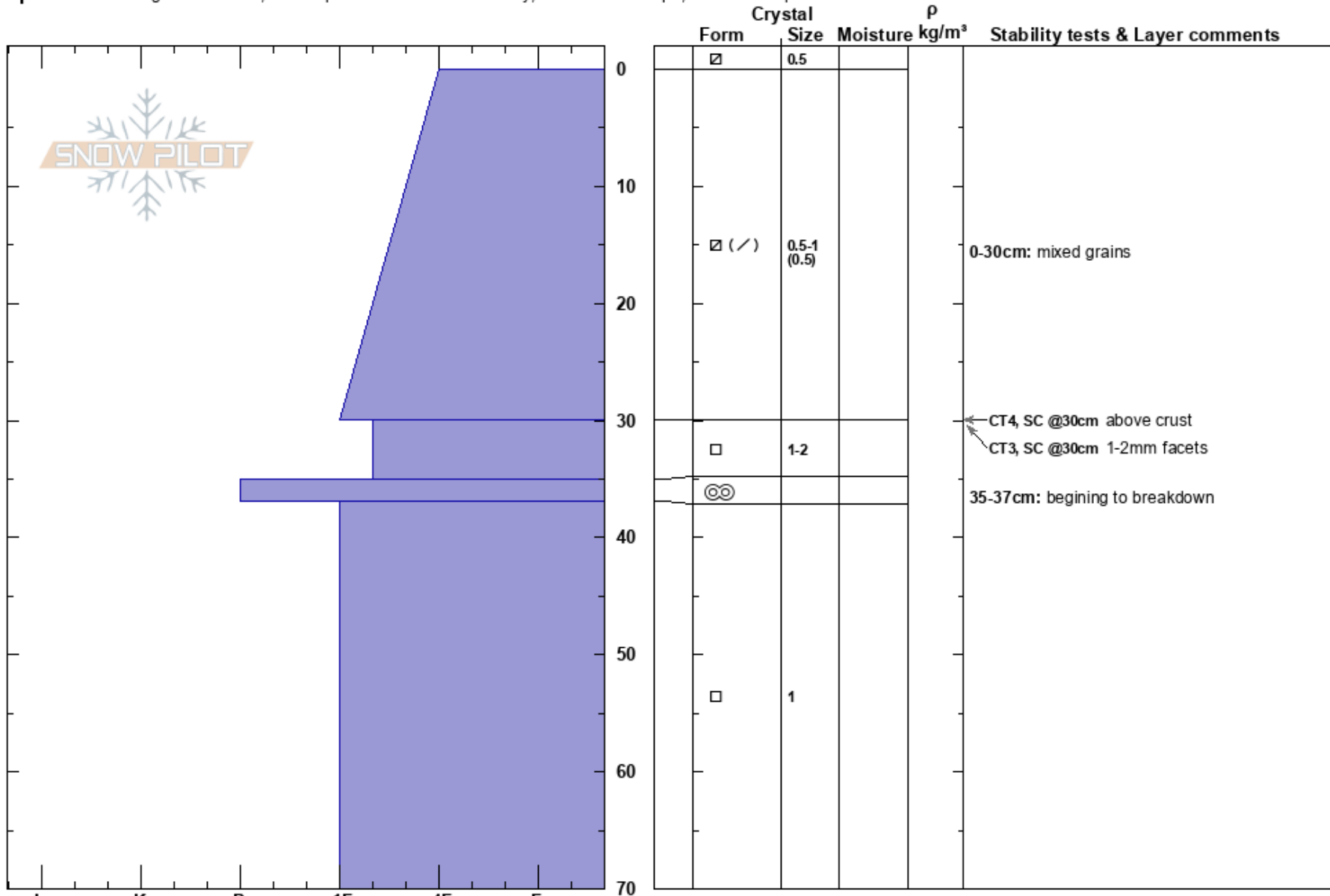

Specifics: Pit dug in a Ski Area; Pit is representative of backcountry; Ski tracks on slope; We skied slope



Notes: Test pit at 1920m at top of NW facing Moraine feature. Slope has few-several medium-large boulders with glacial till ground cover. HS varied between 60-100cm. 241110 MfCr down 35 and breaking down. 2xCTE3 SC down 30 in 1-2mm faceted grains above MfCr. Grains below crust undergoing faceting process, but not yet developed into well defined depth hoar crystals.
