

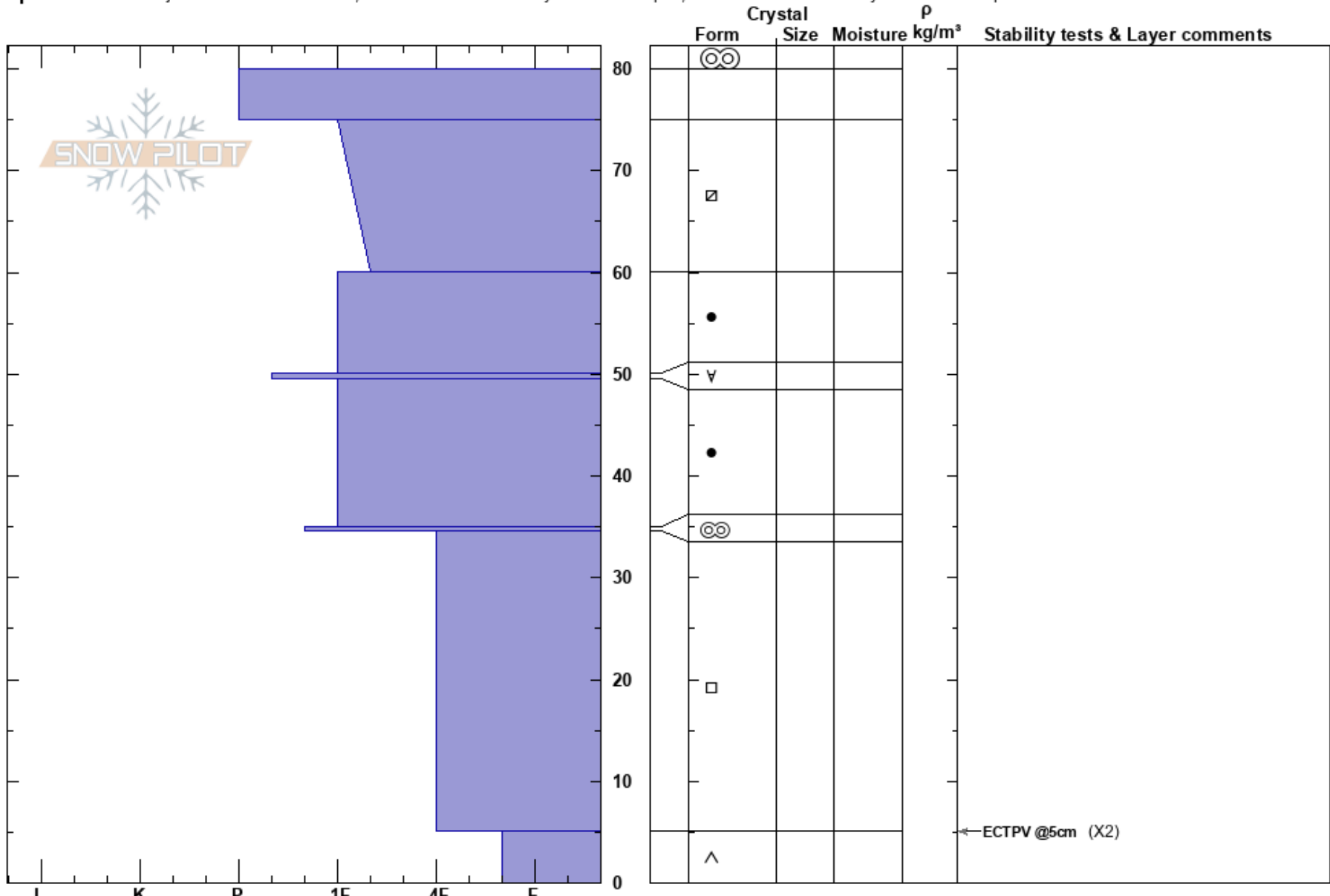

Notes: Dug adjacent to size 3 that likely released 20241127. Surprised to get two ECTPVs- base was cavernous talus and overlying slab was very dense. Probably hard to affect these basal layers due to very stout surface crust and midpack slab.
