

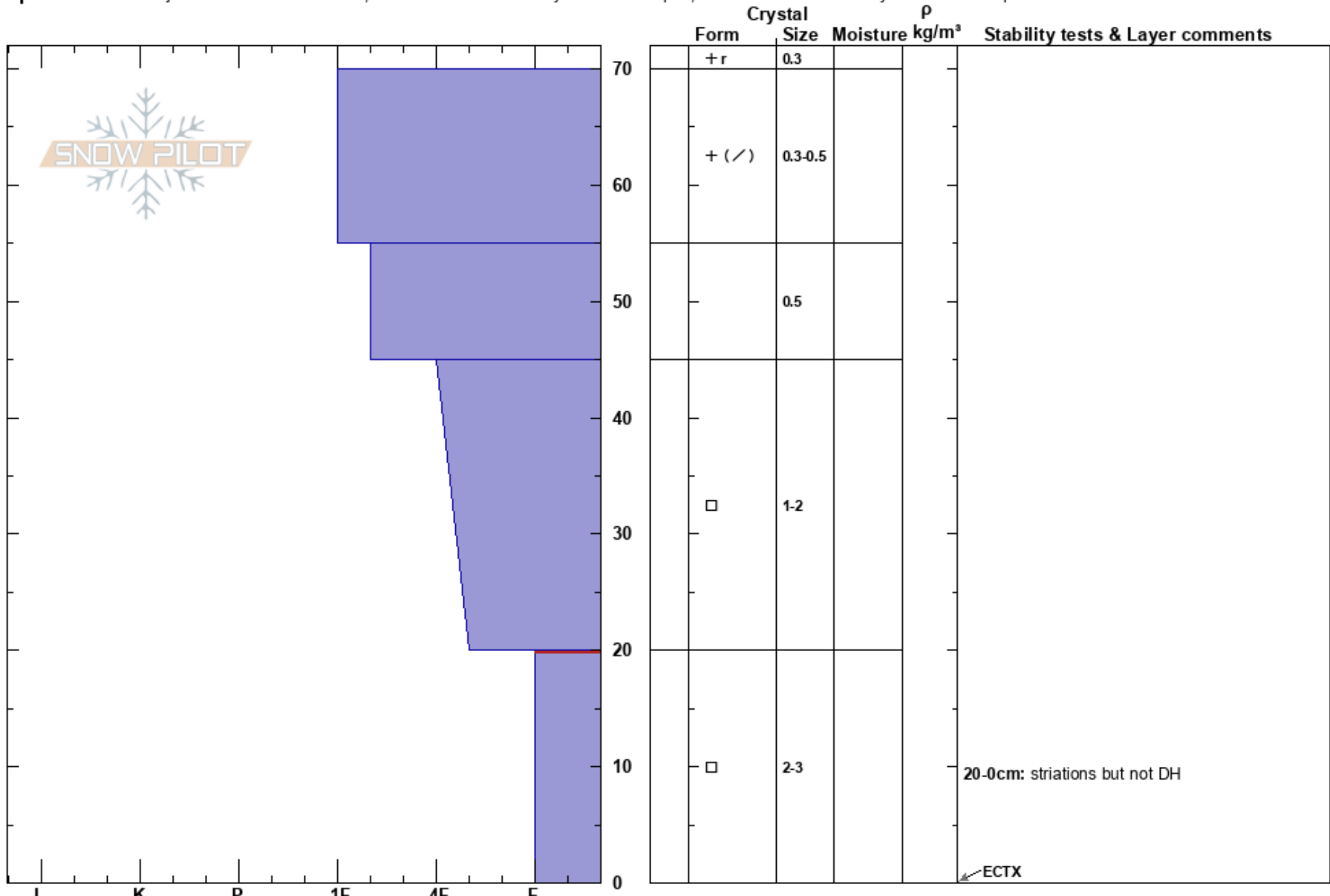

Specifics: Pit is adjacent to avalanche: crown; Recent avalanche activity on similar slopes; Recent avalanche activity on different slopes



**Notes:** This pit was dug in a secondary crown, located approximately 400 vertical feet above the initial skier-triggered crown, in a shallow and representative location below a cliff band. 20 cm: The avalanche initially failed on a 2-3 mm facet layer, stepping down to the ground only in shallow areas where rocks were exposed, of both the bed surface or crown line.
