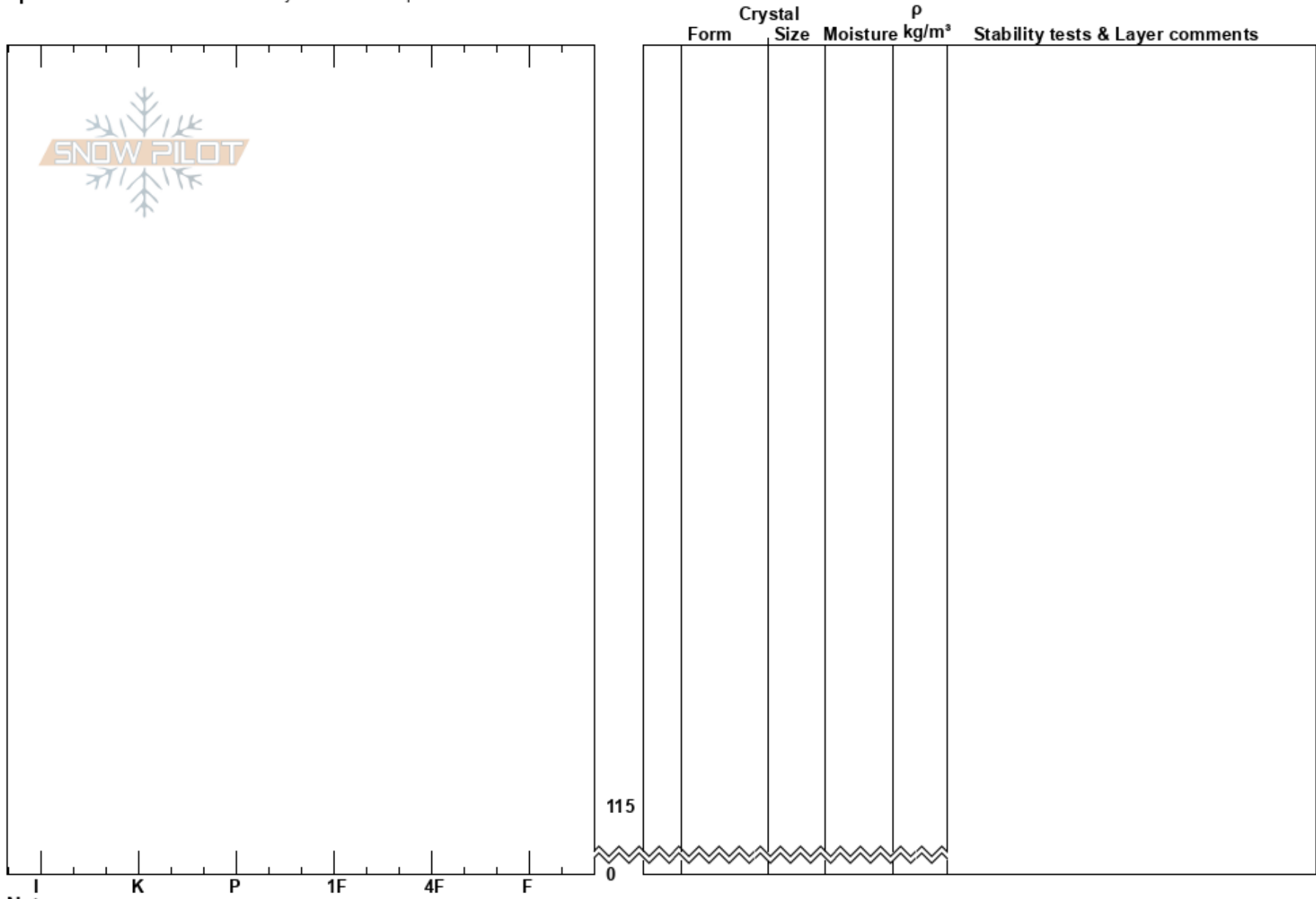

Notes: We dug a pit near dog lake in mill D north at a S aspect at 8760 feet. We found a weak layer of faucets at the ground around 35cm thick. Above think we found a melt freeze crust, and on top of that a pencil hard slab. We had an ect26, that failed right below the melt freeze crust at 35cm and propagated out. We also did a shovel shear test and found a slick crust from last weeks sun did not bond well with our newer snow, we didn't even get to tap the shovel it slid right off with minimal tilt.
