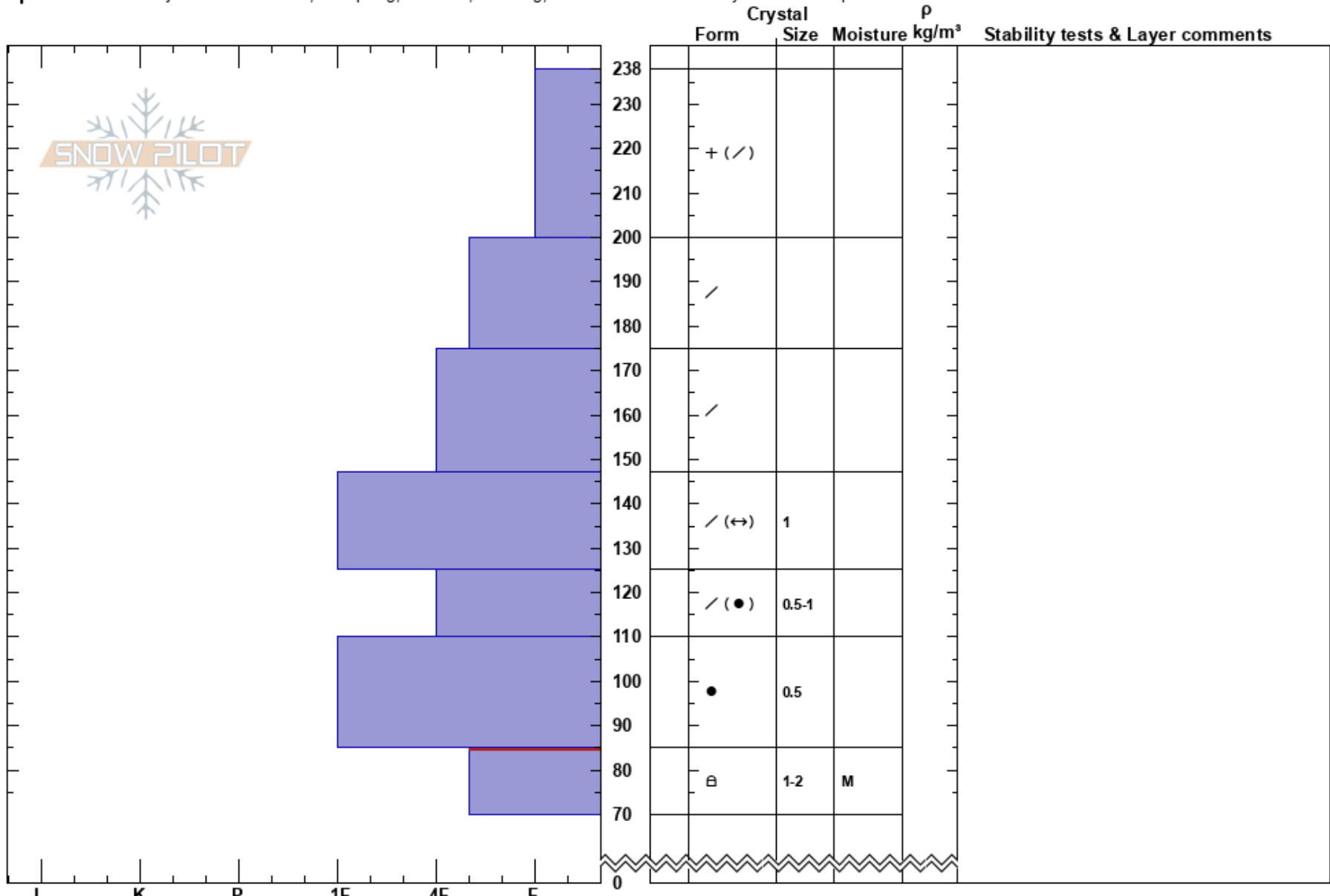

Specifics: Pit is adjacent to avalanche; Collapsing, localized; Cracking; Recent avalanche activity on similar slopes



Notes: Pit dug in one of many shooting cracks that existed on either side of the avalanche. This avalanche was triggered 80 min earlier while digging a snowpit in lower angle terrain approx 500' to the west of the avalanche. This pit data was collected on the eastern side of the avalanche approx 1,000' away from the triggering pit location.
