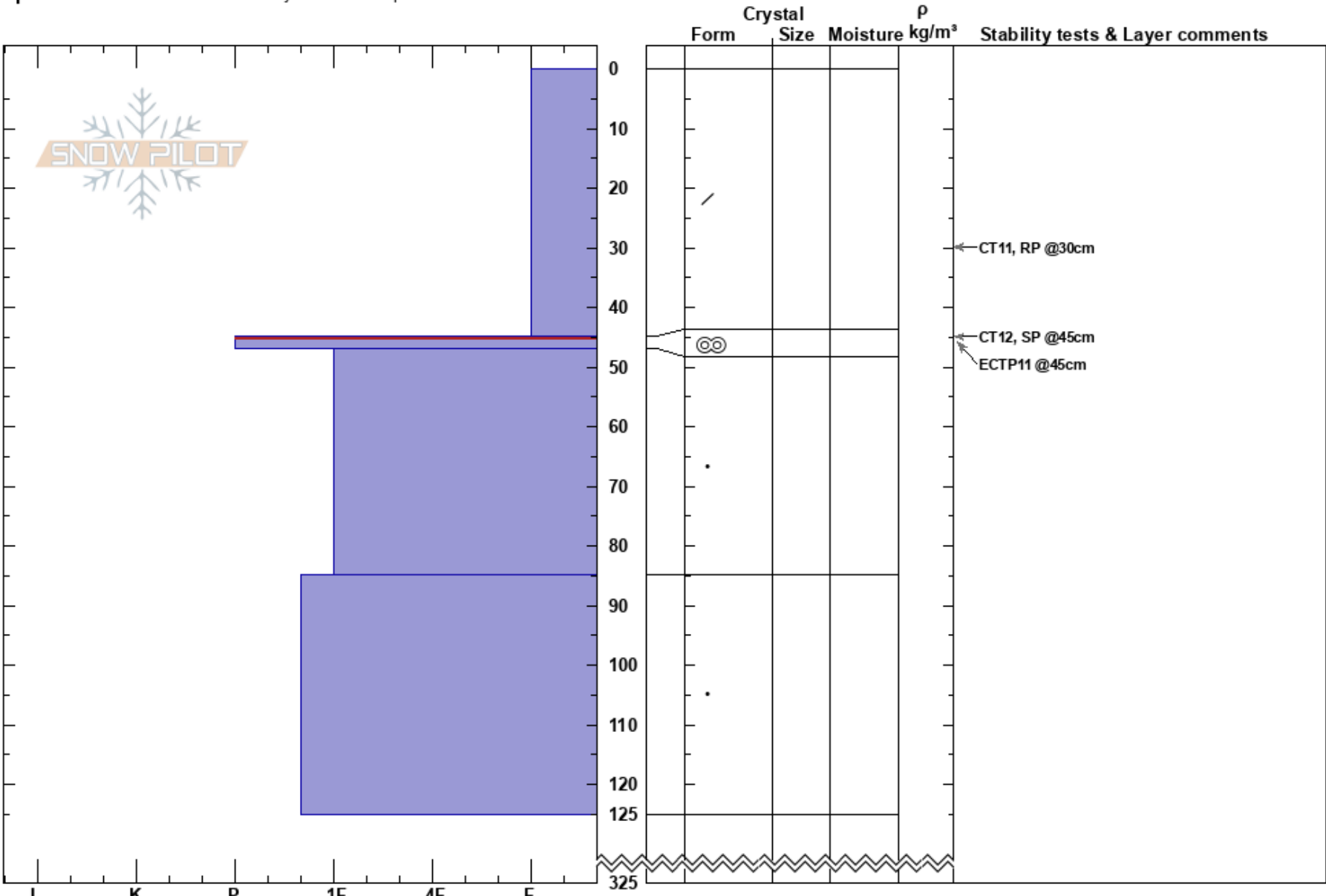

**Notes:** 1.8 inches SWE deposited since final day of high pressure on 3/15. Numerous Class 1-2 Natural and Skier triggered avalanches reported on S through NE facing slopes at Middle and Upper Elevations in the Teton Range everyday since 3/15. Problem layer: Buried Sun crust with Facets 45cm down.
