

Notes: The goal of this pit was to determine whether a graupel layer exists at the bottom of this new snow in our zone. At least in this location, it does not. New snow seemed generally unconsolidated at this elevation. The sun was in and out, mixed with lots of cloud cover and occasional light snow showers. Very unconsolidated (F-) large (3mm+) rounding facets were found below the pit, but may be attributed to large boulders (1M) interspersed in the area.
