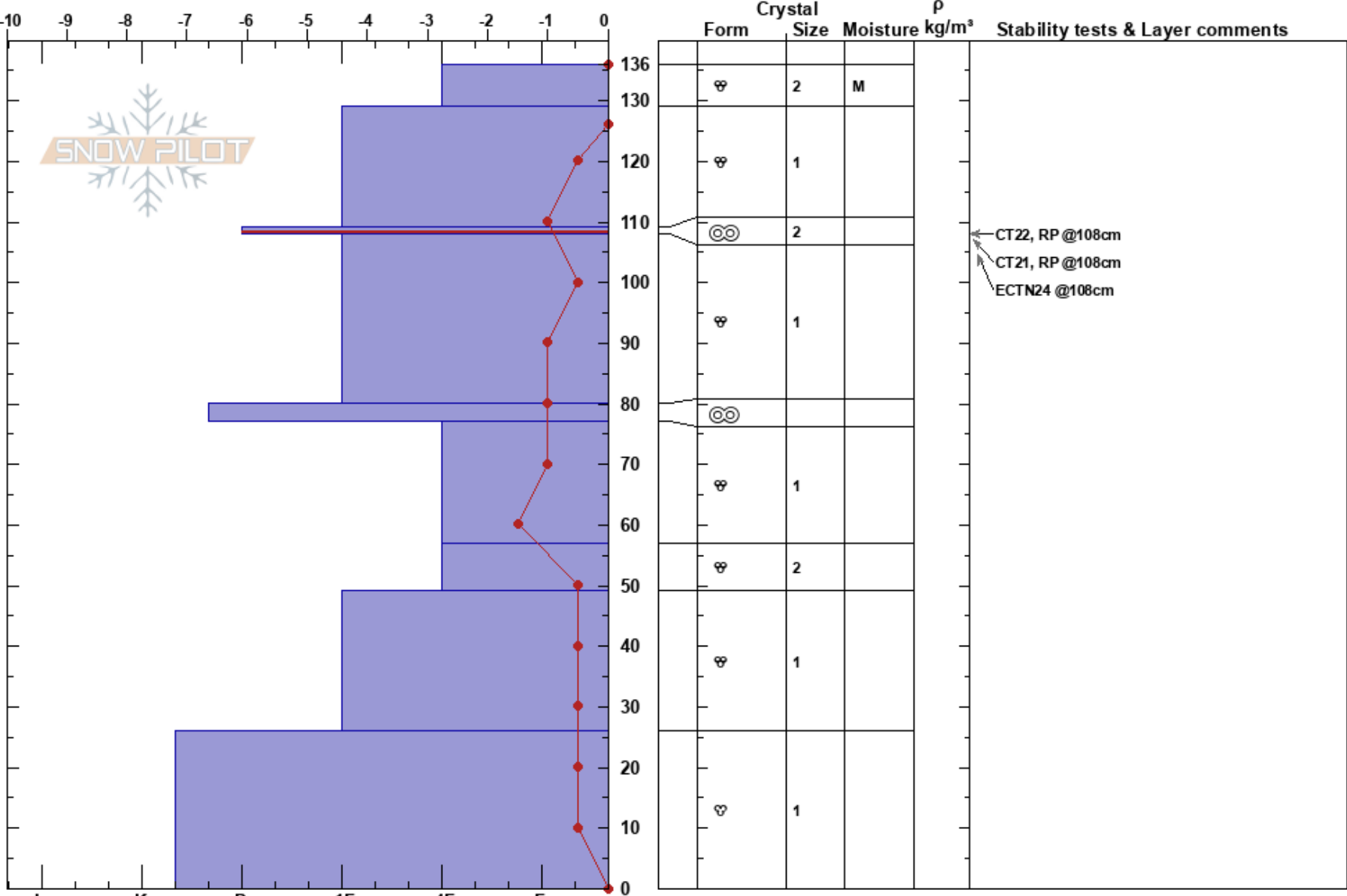

Notes: Dug by Angus and Tim. With layer at 26cm above ground, if there were a few days of warm temps and no freeze, there could be a possibility of water percolation onto this layer and creating a slick bed surface for wet slab potential.
