

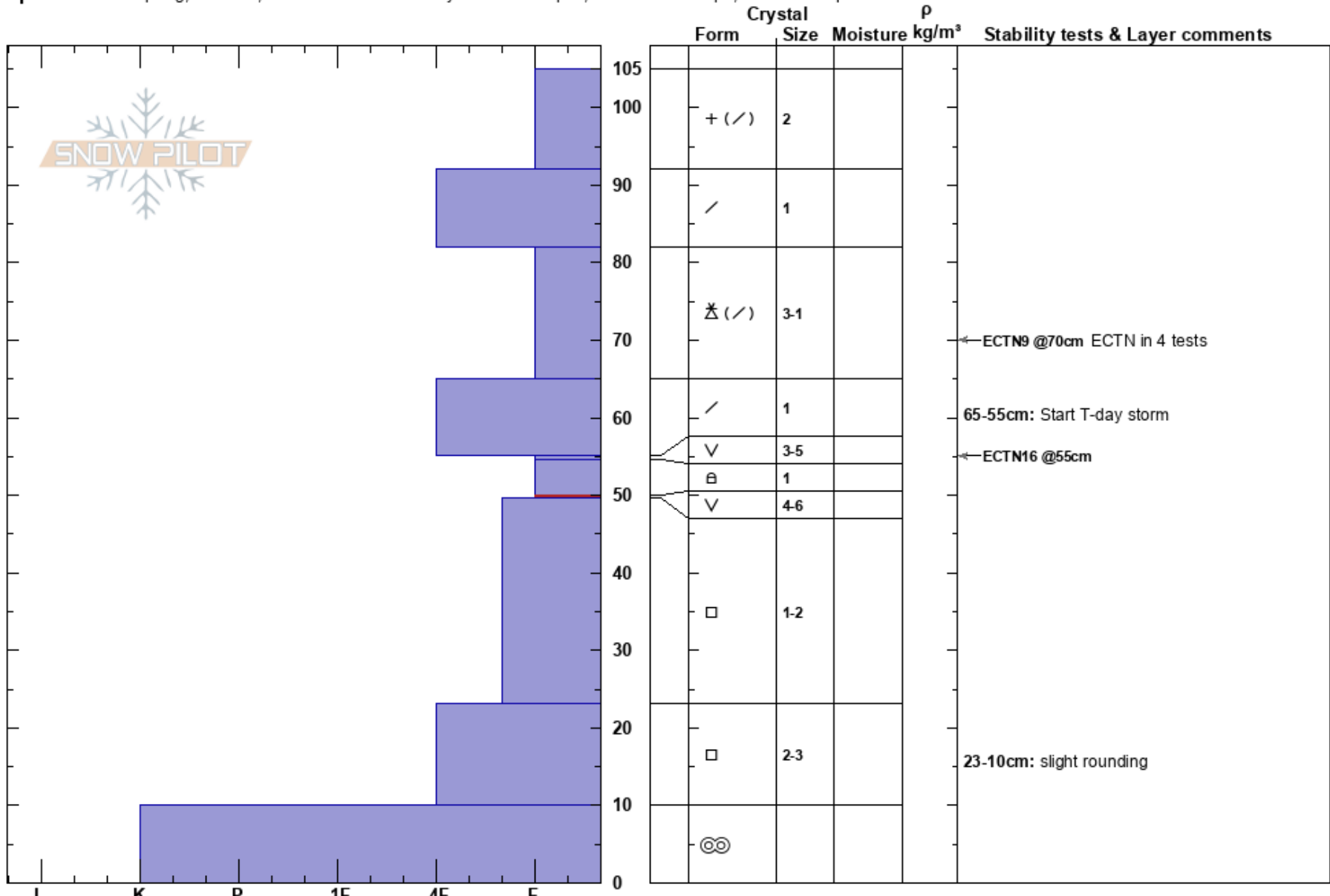

Notes: Several skier triggered slides south of Teton Pass on 11/24. Wolf Trap slide in Avalanchee Bowl was a SS-ASr-R2-D2-O down 50cm on the lower layer of buried surface hoar, but above the November Facet Layer (NFL). Crown profile ECT's did not propagate ~24 hours after the avalanche. Christmas Tree slide initiated in SH and stepped down into facets.
